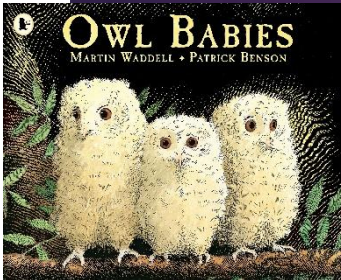


Nursery Autumn 1 2025 - Ourselves

- We will be learning to become more confident in the nursery.

Ourselves



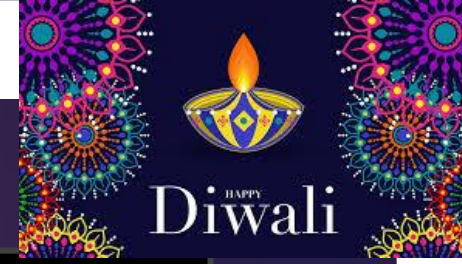
Maths

- We will be learning to recognise groups of objects with more than, fewer than and the same.
- We will be exploring and building with shapes and objects.
- We will be exploring repeating patterns.
- We will be learning to hear and say number names.

Physical Development

- We will be continuing to develop our movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes and bikes) and ball skills.
- Going up steps and stairs, or climbing up apparatus, using alternate feet.
- Skipping, hopping, standing on one leg and hold a pose for a game like musical statues.
- We will be learning to eat independently and learning how to use a knife and fork.
- We will be showing a preference for a dominant hand when we are mark making.

Understanding the World

- We will be learning about our own and other children's families and thinking about similarities and differences.
- We will then discuss similarities and differences between ourselves and our friends.
- We will be looking for signs of Autumn and exploring them with all of our senses.
- We will end the term by learning about Diwali and the story of Rama and Sita.
- We will learn about celebrating Diwali in the UK and in India.



Expressive Arts and Design

- We will be using mirrors to look at our appearances and creating a self portrait.
- We will be making Diya lamps.
- We will be making Autumn pictures using natural resources we have found.
- We will be singing a variety of nursery rhymes including: *Baa baa black sheep, Twinkle, twinkle, little star, Row, row, row your boat, Humpty dumpy*

Suggested Home Learning

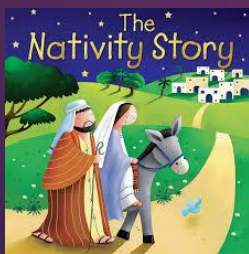
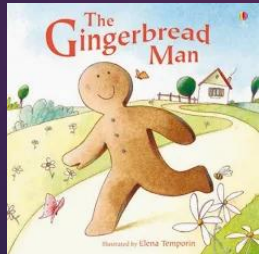
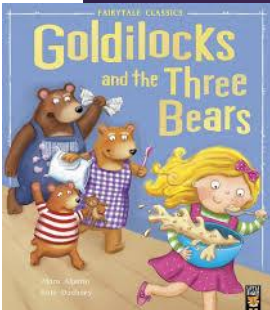
- Spend some time with your families, looking at old photographs of celebrations together and discuss the importance of our own cultures.

Maths

- We will be learning to hear and say number names.

- We will be learning how to make a repeated pattern.
- We will be exploring position and space.

Physical Development

- We will be using large muscle movements to wave flags and streamers, paint and make marks.
- We will start to take part in some group activities that we make up ourselves or in teams.
- We will be increasingly able to use and remember sequences and patterns of movements which are related to music and rhythm.
- We will begin to show increasing preference for a dominant hand.
- We will be increasingly independent in getting dressed and undressed (putting coats on, doing zips..)



Understanding the World

- We will be learning how to make porridge and exploring how the oats change.
- We will be sorting materials into hard and soft.
- We will be making gingerbread men and exploring how the ingredients change when they are combined and cooked.
- We will be exploring how The Gingerbread Man changes when he swims in water and whether he floats or sinks.
- We will be learning about Christmas and how it is celebrated.
- We will be making salt dough Christmas decorations



Expressive Arts and Design

- We will be exploring colour mixing.
- We will be learning to sing in tune.
- We will be designing our own gingerbread man.
- We will be using a variety of materials to make a boat for The Gingerbread Man.

We will be singing a variety of nursery rhymes including: *Pat a cake, Little Miss Muffet, Star light star bright, Jack and Jill, Polly put the kettle on*

Suggested Home Learning

- Go for a walk in the park and look for the signs of Winter together.
- Cook something simple together and talk about how the food changes.
- Practice eating with a knife and fork
- Practice putting your own coat on and learn how to do the zip.
- Play games together with rules.
