We will be learn about:

Number: Place Value (within 10)

We will learn to:

- subitise within 5, including when using a rekenrek, and re-cap the composition of 5
- develop their understanding of the numbers 6 to 9 using the '5 and a bit' structure
- compare numbers within 10 and use precise mathematical language when doing so "greater than" "fewer than"
- re-cap the order of numbers within 10 and connect this to '1 more' and '1 less' than a given number

Book - It's a No Money Day

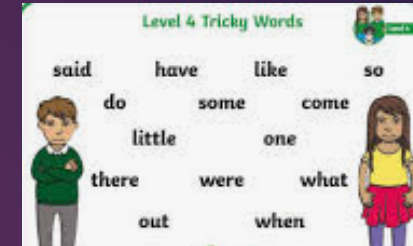
- We will be focusing on developing reading and writing skills including:

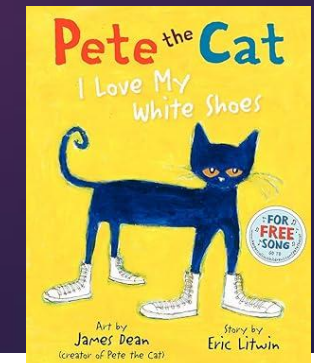
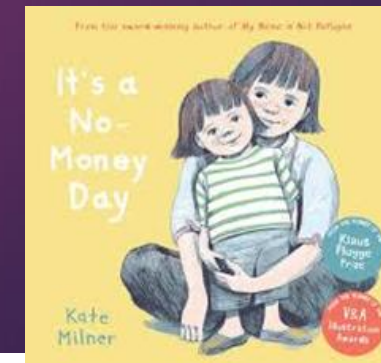

Number: Place Value (beyond 10)

Number: Addition and Subtraction (within 20)

Geometry: Shape

- Begin using a number line to count on and back
- Practically add amounts and manipulatives to find a total
- Develop their understanding of what happens to an amount when you take away
- Identify and name 2D shapes
- Understand properties of shapes

 - Using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops to write simple sentences

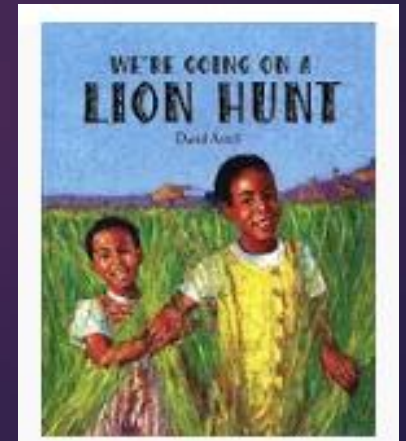
