Communication and Language and PSED

- We will be learning to talk about our families and to understand that they are valuable and special.
- We will be learning about why it is important to share and cooperate with others.
- We will be learning to see ourselves as valuable individuals.
- We will be learning why listening is important.
- We will be learning to use full sentences when communicating.

Literacy

- We will read the stories The Three Little Pigs and The Three Billy Goats Gruff.
- We will read the non-fiction text The Great Big Book of Families'
- We will be learning Level 1 and 2 phonics.
- We will be joining in with story time.
- We will be learning why it is important to listen.
- We will be learning to hold a pencil effectively using a tripod grip.

Maths

- We will be learning to count objects, actions and sounds.
- We will be learning to link the number symbol (numeral) with its cardinal number value.
- We will be learning to sing number songs and rhymes with the numbers counting forwards.
- We will be learning that counting is useful because it tells us 'how many'.
- We will be learning to compare quantities (more/fewer).

Physical Development

- We will be learning how to march, its actions, being in time and moving in different directions.
- We will be learning to march in unison, keeping in time with the music.
- We will be learning to individually create a march pathway.
- We will be learning to observe and describe marching movements.

Understanding the World

- We will be looking at baby photos of ourselves to see what we looked like in the past.
- We will be sorting pictures into past and present.
- We will be learning how to recognise similarities and differences between the past and today.
- We will be asking questions about the differences we see in photos showing the past.
- We will begin to use common words and phrases for the passage of time.

- We will be exploring making marks and patterns using wax crayons, felt tips, chalk and pencils.

- We will be learning to make large and small movements.





Physical Development

- We will be learning to walk, run, jump and skip in a space, without bumping into others.
- We will explore using our bodies to make shapes.
- We will be learning to perform and link different tuck shapes.
- We will be learning to perform the fun gym shapes with control.
- We will be learning to link the shapes with a short movement, showing control.

Understanding the World

- We will be learning how to get information from maps.
- We will be exploring the natural world around us.
- We be learning to describe what we see, hear and feel whilst outside.
- We will be learning to compare our environment with ones that are different.
- We will be visiting the church and learning that some places are special to members of our community.

Expressive Arts and Design

- We will be exploring paint through finger painting, describing the texture and colours.
- We will be making our own paintbrushes using natural objects we find.
- We will be creating large pieces of art work based on fireworks.
